Please note:

- Intro text will be discussed with the TDM Technical Committee Sprint Team
- The grayed-out modes (“Lyft/Uber,” “Employer Shuttle,” and “Other”) in question 2 will be optional modes that you can include in your survey.
- Question 2 will have follow up questions depending on the answers selected. If at least one mode is carpool, the respondent will be asked a follow up question about occupancy (after they finish filling out the entire mode matrix). The same would occur for vanpool and TNC responses.
 - In a later version, we propose to include a question about what “last-mile” mode was used by respondents who indicate public transportation as a primary mode.
