

Mobility Partnerships Grant – Legislative language

\$25,000,000 (per biennium) is provided solely for a program to improve mobility and reduce greenhouse gas emissions for vulnerable populations, overburdened communities, tribes, and rural communities through transportation demand management.

Mobility Partnerships will develop proposals to address a transportation need identified in a local, regional, transit, or state plan through transportation demand management; conduct community engagement; obtain funding; support project delivery; and report project performance. Funding will be provided for delivery of transportation demand management projects proposed by mobility partnerships.

A non-profit, public agency or tribe may establish a Mobility Partnership. To be eligible for funding a public agency or tribe must be a member of the Mobility Partnership.

The department and the Transportation Demand Management Technical Committee shall develop the grant program. The department will report the results to the legislature of the Mobility Partnerships grant program biennially. The department and Transportation Demand Management Technical Committee will describe the funded projects and what they achieved.
