

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Recognition Program – The Past

Spokane County has had a recognition program since 1995

Recognized only employers who made their CTR goal or made 50% towards their goal

In 2016, of 112 employers, only 17 were recognized for their survey results

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What we realized

Many employers had great CTR programs – offering many program elements

We had ETCs who went above & beyond to market their programs, but due to survey results, were never recognized for their efforts



2016 - Time for a change!

We used Commute Seattle's Awards program as a template

Added some elements of our own

Wanted a tool our ETCs could use to have conversations with management

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

Impact on CTR Survey Results

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


