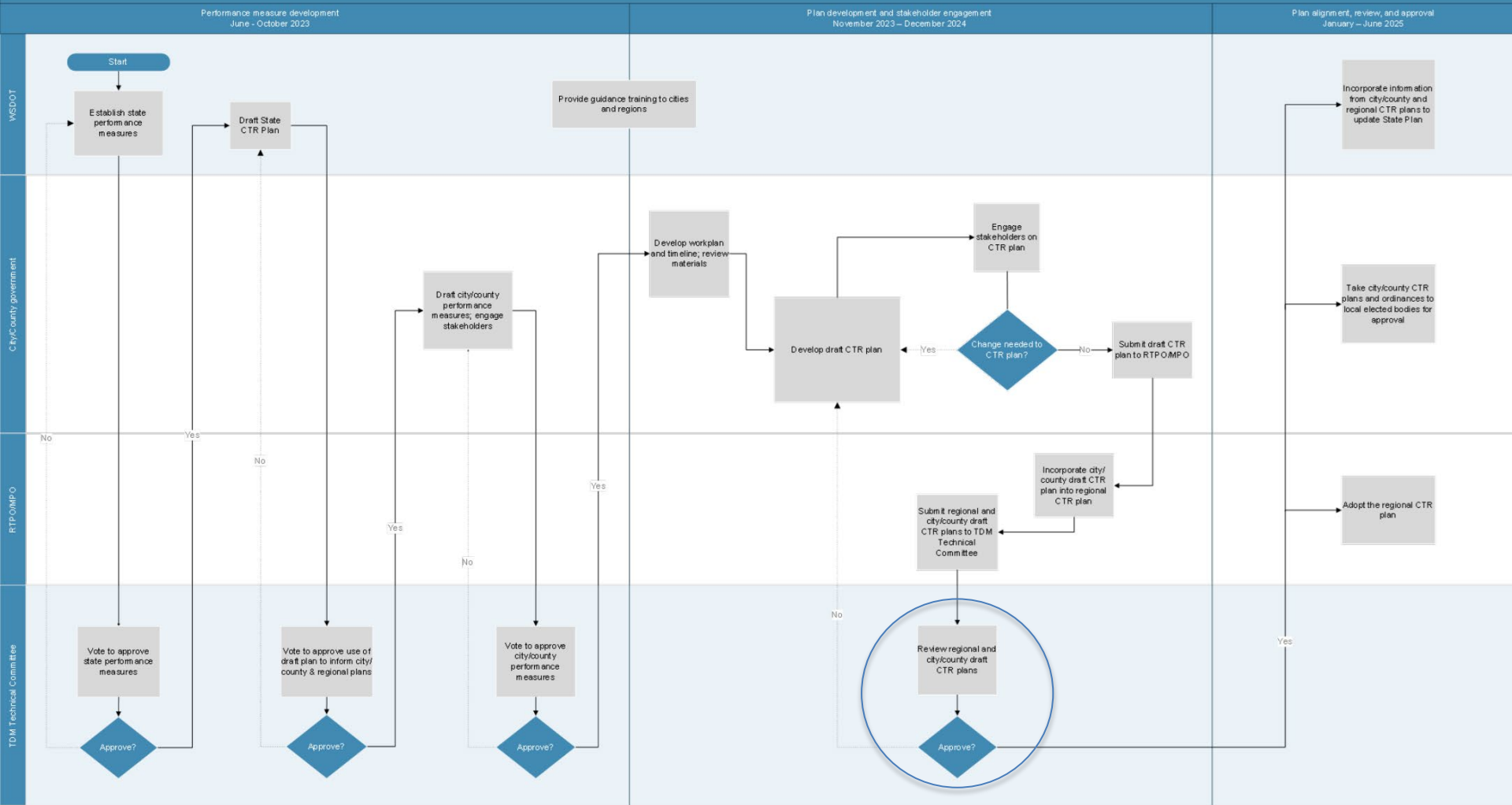

3. **TDM Technical Committee: Approval**
4. **Local Role: Final Adoption**

CTR plan development process (for cities and counties)



What we discussed:

What role does TDM Technical Committee want to have in approval of the plans beyond compliance? (They are not required to have a role beyond compliance, but if they wanted to go above and beyond they could. What would that look like?)

Discussion Outcome

No proposal is needed; however, this subcommittee recommends:

- The TDM Technical approves the 4-Year Plans based on compliance of the CTR Law.
- The TDM Technical Committee will use WSDOT's compliance review to make their decision.
- A collaborative trends report to outline themes of the Local CTR 4-Year Plans will be shared with the TDM Technical Committee.
- WSDOT will look to the TDM Technical Committee to define what will be included in a trend report based on local plans. The TDM Technical Committee will receive that report.

Discussion Outcome

- Enhance each jurisdiction's CTR 4-Year Plan with meaningful feedback.
- Support the TDM Technical Committee to learn more about each jurisdiction's CTR 4-Year Plans.
