WHEREAS, the state of Washington has been a leader in TDM for over 30 years with its successful Commute Trip Reduction program administered by the Washington state Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the TDM practitioners' partner with communities, developers and corporations to improve the quality of life of commuters, enhance the livability of communities and stimulate economic activity;
