

CO-LOCATED STATE AGENCY CTR WORKSITES

DECISION PROPOSAL TO TDM TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

TDM Technical Committee September 2025

PURPOSE

Provide clarity to implementers regarding when a joint program is required of co-located state agency worksites outside Thurston County.

Recommendation: Develop joint program for worksites affected by 70A.15.4100 (2) when state agency co-located worksites are unable to develop an individual CTR program.

BACKGROUND

70A.15.4100 (2). "State agencies sharing a common location (...) where the total number of state employees is one hundred or more shall, with assistance from the department of transportation, develop and implement a joint commute trip reduction program. The worksite must be treated as specified in RCW 70A.15.4040 and 70A.15.4050."

ASSESSMENT

- This situation is rare.
- 70A.15.4040 requirements are difficult to distribute.
- State agencies provide different benefits (policy or negotiated).
- Worksites develop programs that best address their workforce and location.
- 70A.15.4100 (2) is best applied when no CTR program exists.

RECOMMENDATION

Proposal for decision:

Develop joint program for worksites affected by 70A.15.4100 (2) when state agency co-located worksites are unable to develop an individual CTR program.
