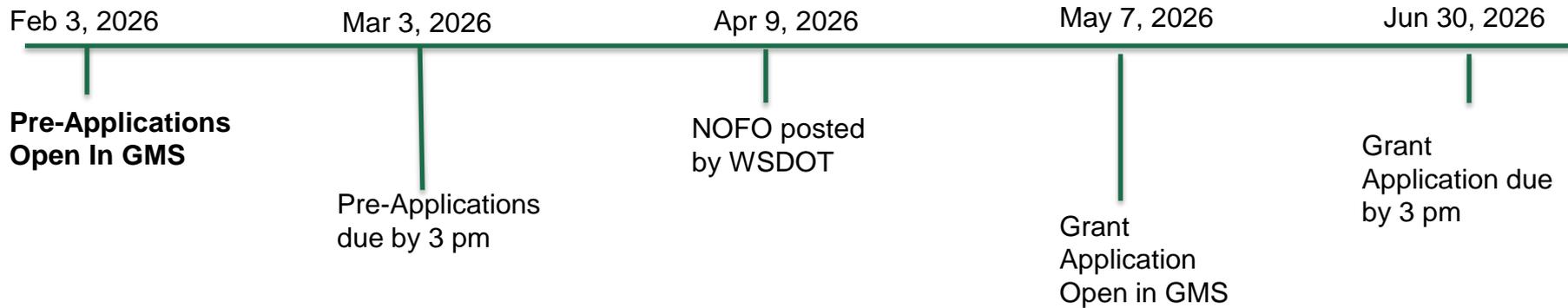
Program overview

- The Regional Mobility Grant Program supports local efforts to improve connectivity between counties and regional population centers and reduce transportation delay.
- State only funded grant ([RCW 47.66.030](#)).
- Funded projects are those proposed to deliver public benefits as quickly as possible.
- Public benefit is determined based on two metrics Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) and Vehicle Trips (VT)

What's New for 2025- 2027 biennium

- TDM Team will now provide Grant Management for TDM-related projects
- Combination grants will have improved oversight due to increased coordination
- Our focus for this biennium:
 - PMP**
 - Annual Reports for previous grants**
 - Quarterly Status reports**
 - Claims**

What's New

Current project areas:

- Enhance CTR (e.g., incentives, transit passes).
- Encourage a mode shift (e.g., transit, walking, and biking).
- Outreach to employers to increase the use of teleworking.
- First- and last-mile connections programs (e.g., public transit rideshare expansion).

Growth project areas

- **Mitigate construction** through added transit, rideshare service, or other solutions (e.g., community festivals, major sporting events).
- **Licensing technology** or software for the coordination of various trip reduction options to mitigate congestion (e.g., route optimization, managing commutes).

Ex. 1 Construction Mitigation

- Changes to signal and lane configurations
- Multiple areas of traffic control
- Sidewalk disruptions
- limited traffic control on the traveled way



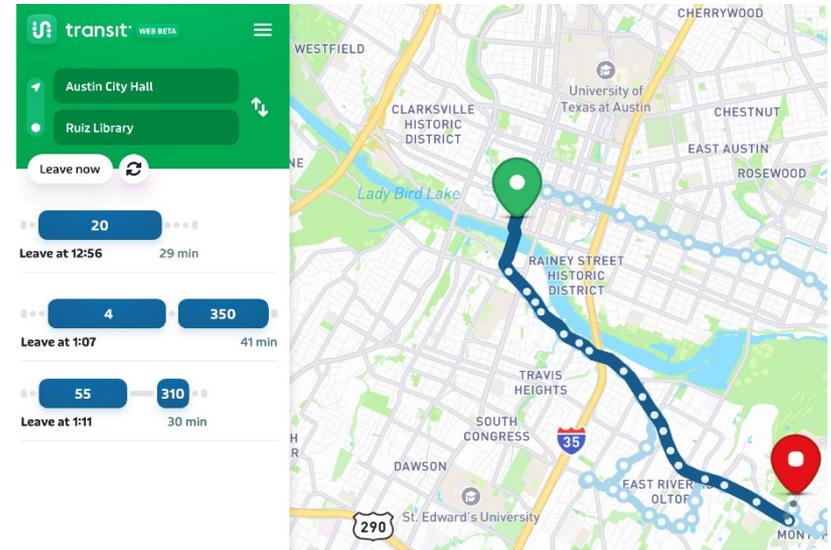
Ex. 2 Major Event Mitigation

- **Reduced traffic congestion**
- **Collaborating with the local transit agency**
- **Reduction of VT, SOV, and VMT**
- **Safer Commute around the event**
