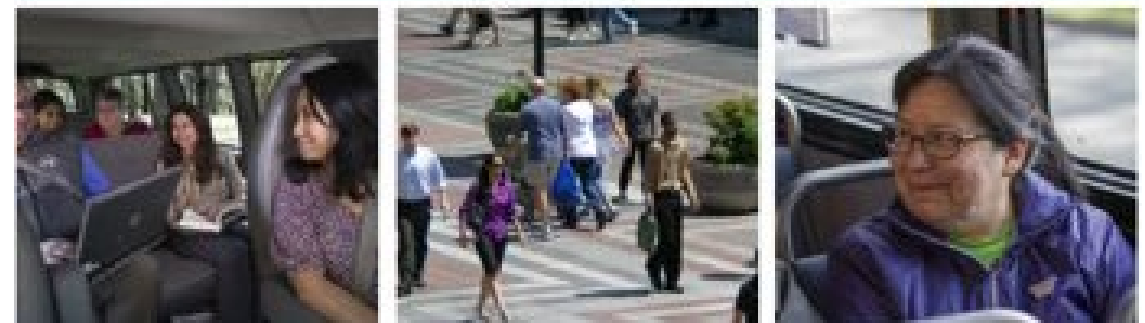
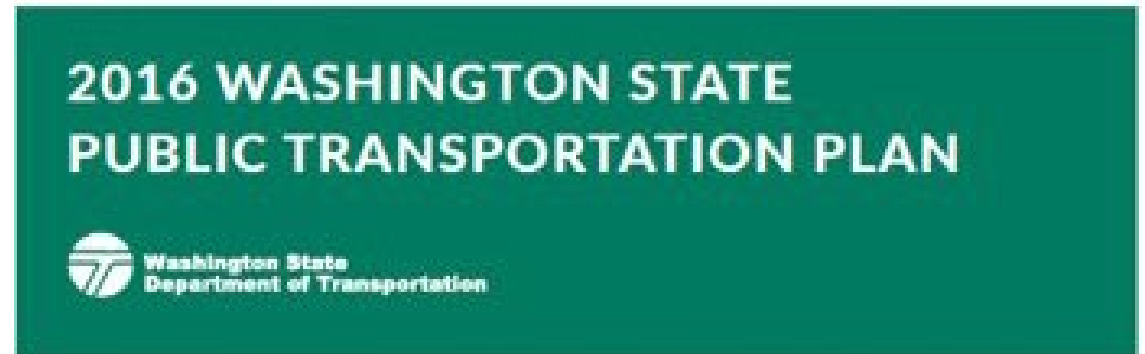

What is the Public Transportation Plan?

The plan:

1. Outlines the state interest in public transportation
2. Influences public transportation priorities, planning, and investments in Washington
3. 2016 plan lays out high level strategies and goals:
 - Thriving communities
 - Access
 - Adaptive transportation capacity
 - Customer experience
 - Transportation system guardianship



Public Transportation Plan Organizing Principle and Vision Statement

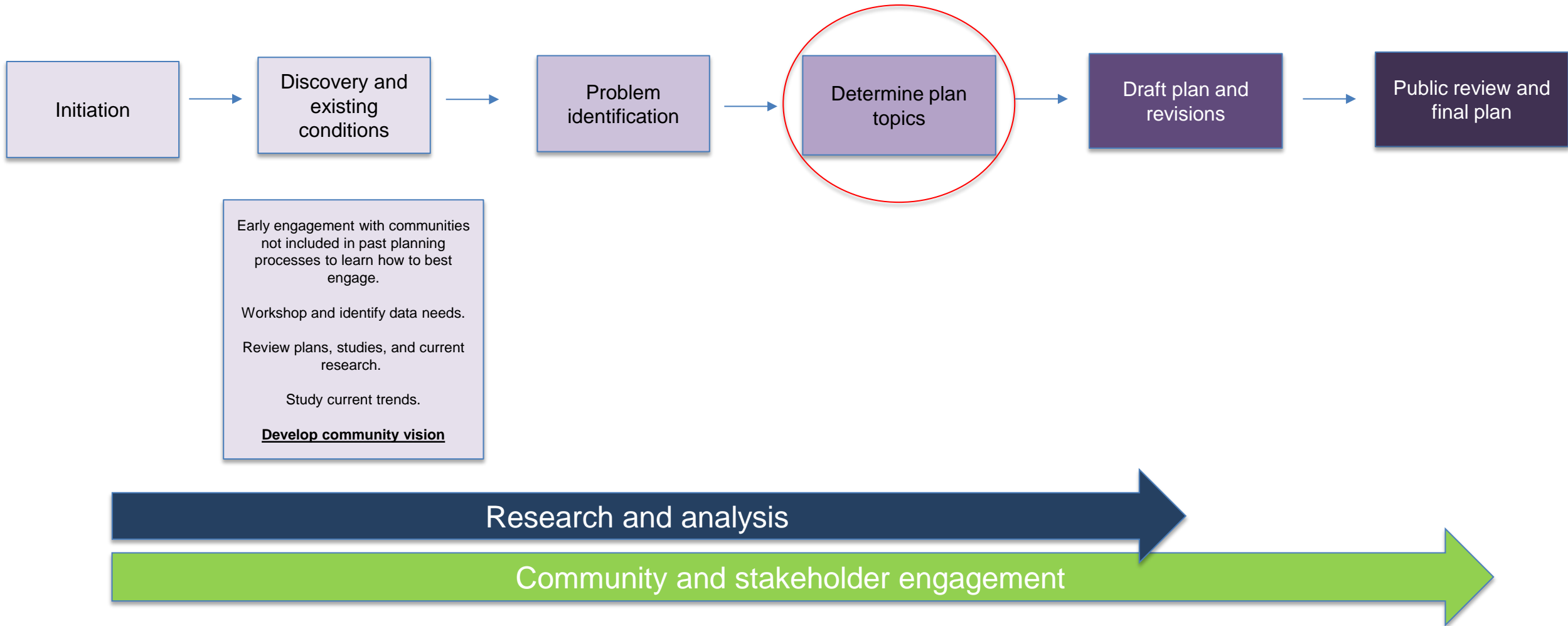
- **Organizing principles:**

- *Washington State has a public transportation system that is easy, connected, and centers the needs and aspirations of non-drivers.*

Need for more public transportation to meet community needs



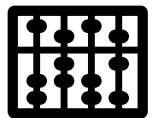
Need for more environmental justice investment

Available funding is difficult to access

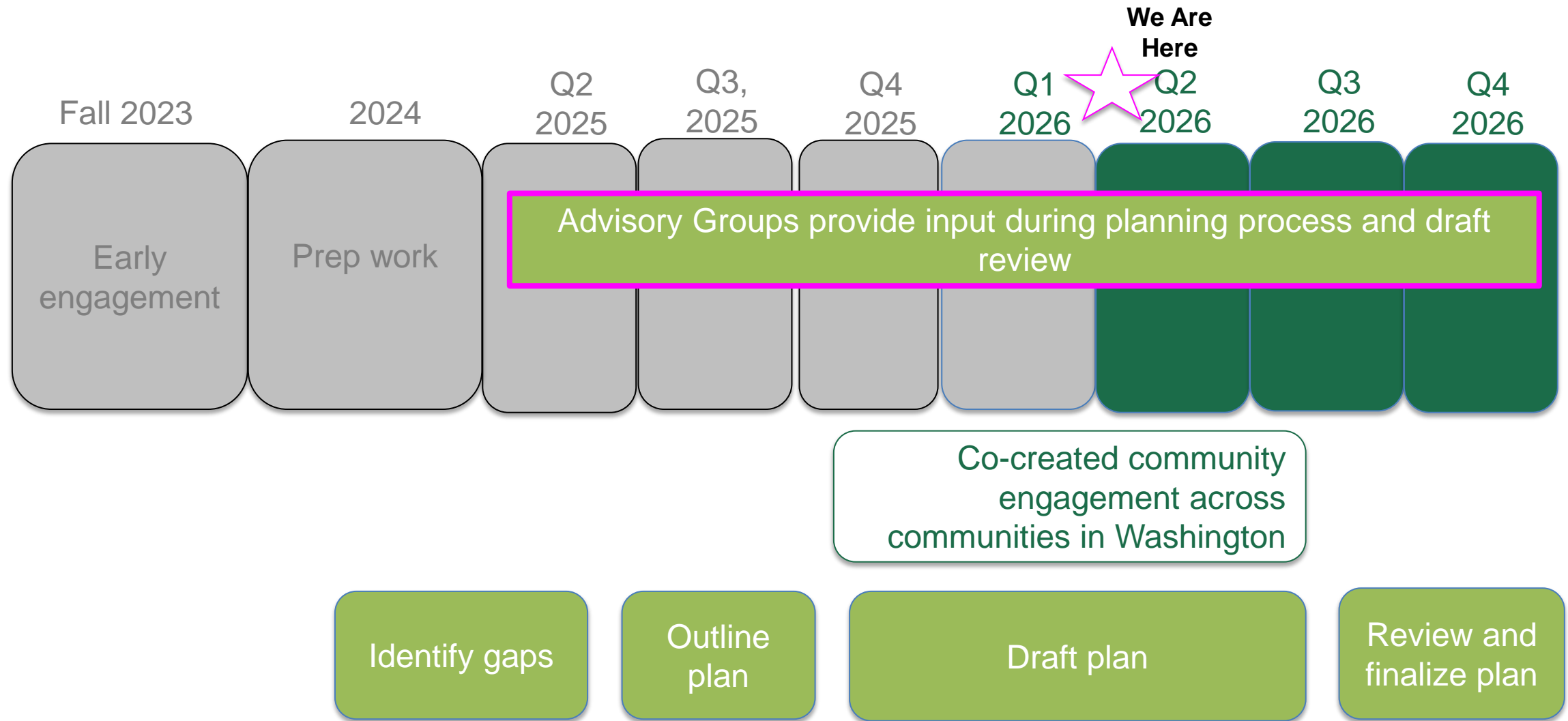


No consistent way to measure public transportation access

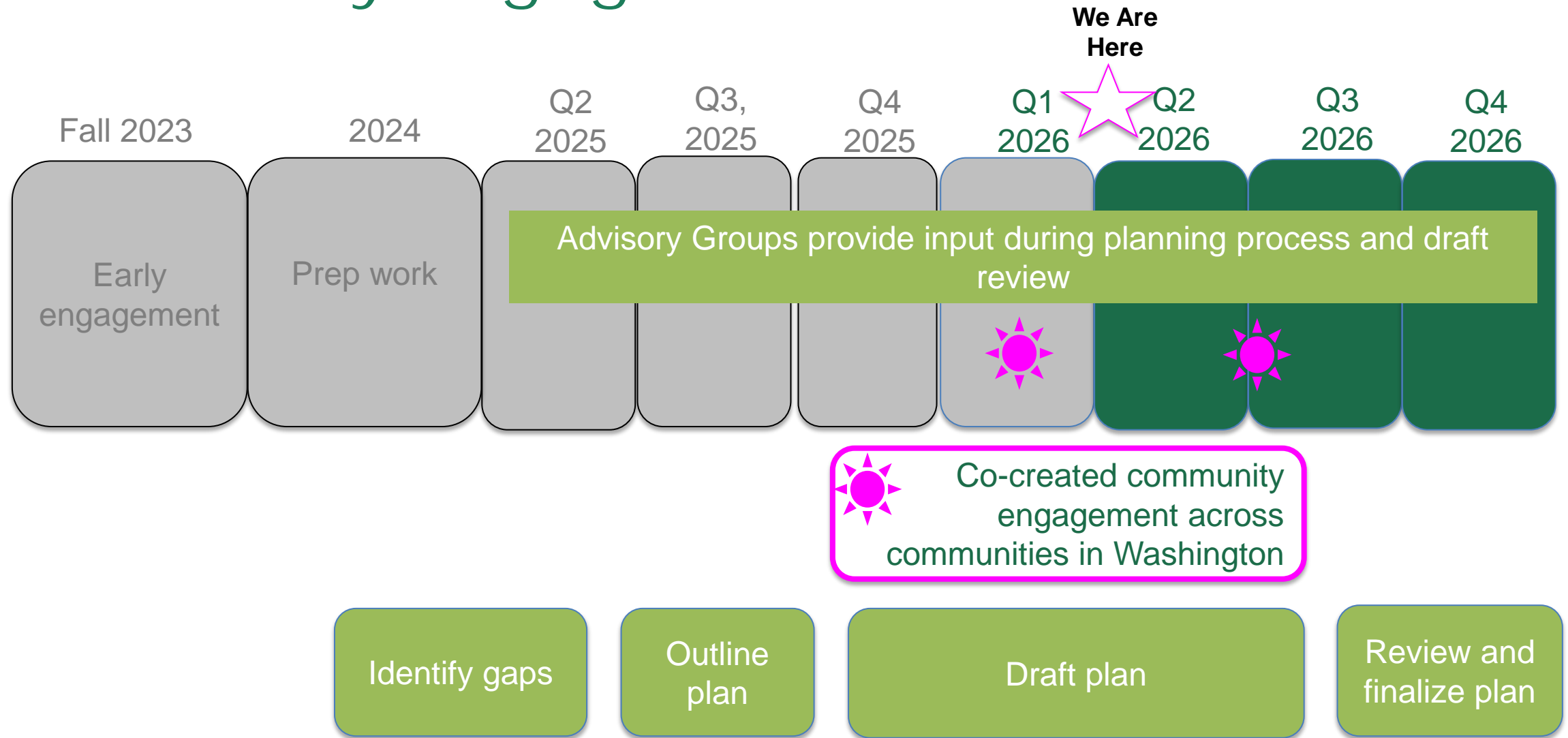


Real and perceived operational and personal safety challenges

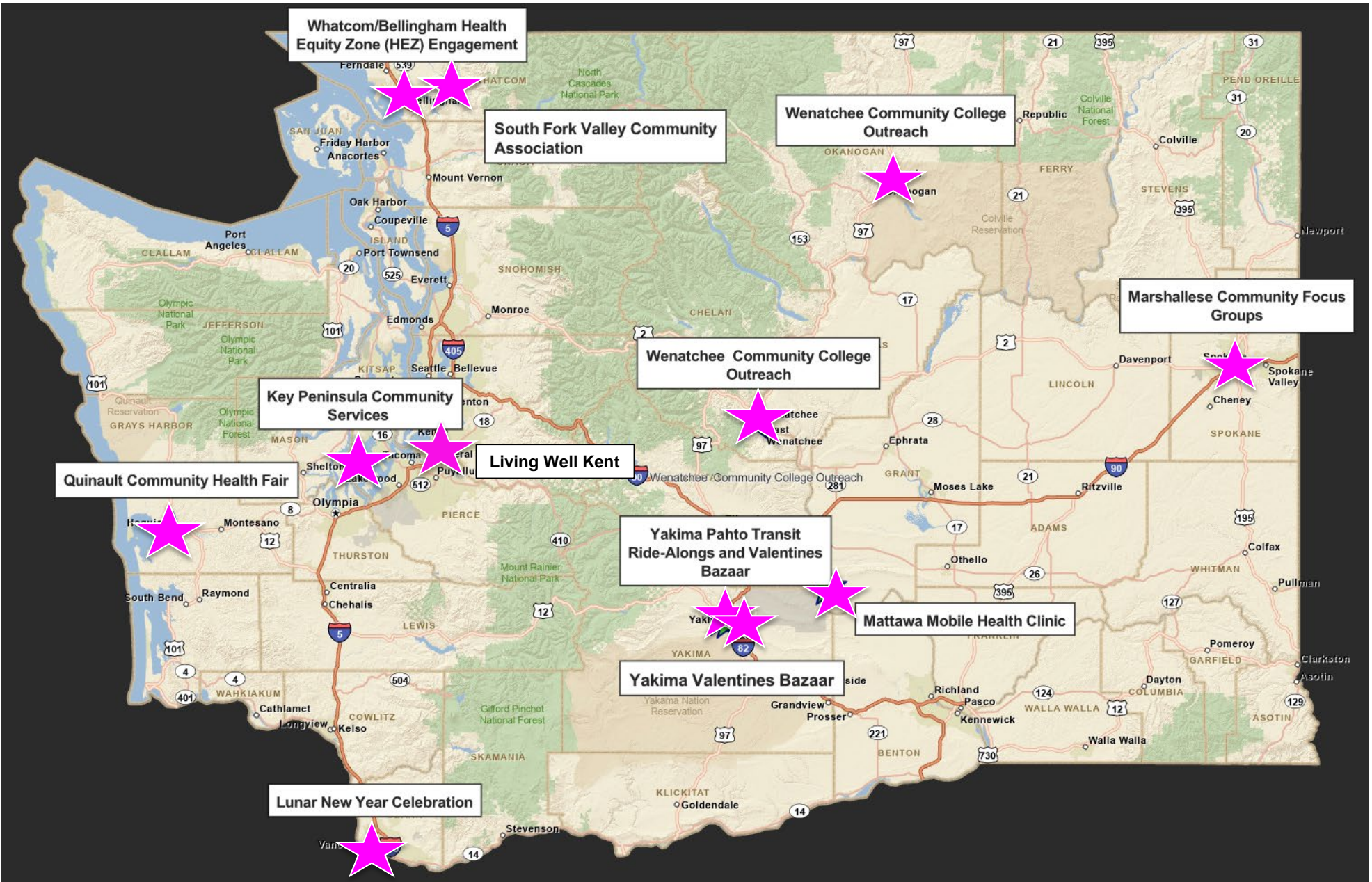
