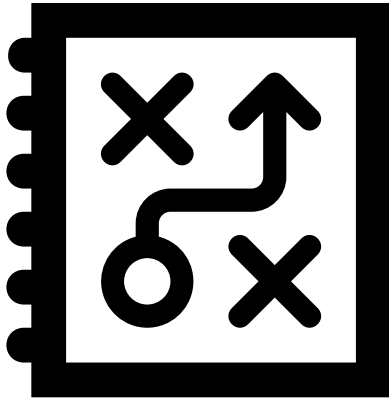

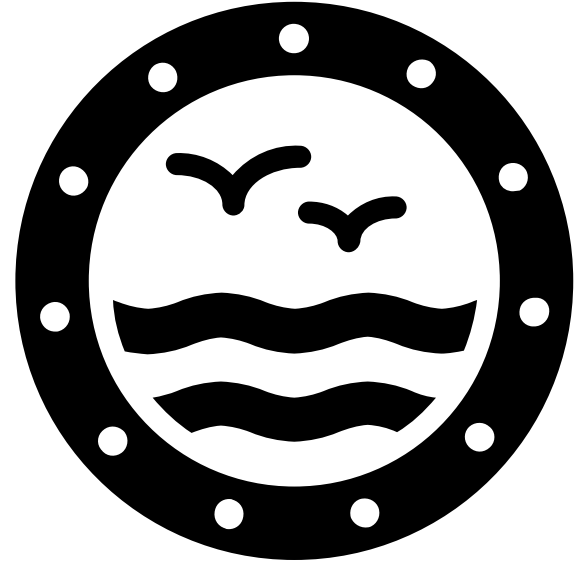
Try a new approach...

“I feel with the WSDOT leadership transition, and natural cycle of TDM leaders, the 2024 retreat results may become outdated. At a minimum, a Strategic Planning session would be an opportunity to re-tool the 2024 proposals, to make them more meaningful for today’s leaders”

“I think these could be less often, like twice a year, in person work sessions where we talk through how to develop and implement new policies and win more funding for them in the legislature. It could also invite legislators in to learn more about these conversations.”

WSDOT Recommendation:

Pilot Combined TDM Technical Committee and TDM Executive Board Meetings

This solution comes from a review of response themes.

What does this entail?

Logistics

- 1-year pilot of combining both the Executive Board and TDM Technical Committee meetings
- Meeting cadence does not change (quarterly for the Executive Board, monthly for the TDM Technical Committee)
- The TDM Executive Board's schedule will overlay with the TDM Technical Committee
- Both groups will review this pilot after 4 meetings
- This change is set to begin in **July**
- No votes are held at combined meetings

Expected Benefits

A revitalized governance structure designed for leadership, initiative, and broader communications. Specific meeting agendas corresponding to times of the year or parties invited.

- Information sharing becomes seamless
- Great potential networking opportunities
- Clearer connection to the TDM work happening in both groups
